HB 144 Resources

- What is HB 144? -A Utah law that allows qualified undocumented students to pay in-state tuition rather than non-resident tuition.
 - > Student must have attended a UTAH high school for three (3) years or more consecutive years.
 - Students must have graduated from a UTAH high school with a diploma or G.E.D.
 - > Student must NOT be registered as an entering student at a Utah college or university before the fall semester of 2002.
 - > Students must have filed an application to legalize their immigration status or will file an application as soon as they are eligible (In other words, when the student has an opportunity to change his or her legal status, they will.)
